Since 1984 the mission of Hospitality House has been to rebuild lives and strengthen community by providing a safe, nurturing, and healthy evironment in which individuals and families experiencing homelessness and poverty-related crises are equipped to become self sufficient and productive. We accomplish this through providing shelter, food, and supportive services for those in our service area.

39,269 nights of shelter, food, and supportive services

Hunger Relief

The Bread of Life Community Kitchen serves 3 meals a day, 365 days a year, averaging *11,444 meals each month*. Associated food costs soared 196% due to COVID-19 safety protocols.



The Emergency Food Pantry served 9,247 people. Demand for food boxes increased by 49% during the first six months of the COVID-19 pandemic.



Housing

Our programs include Winter Seasonal Shelter, Emergency Shelter Program, Family Housing, Permanent Supportive Housing, Domestic Violence Transitional Housing, Rapid Rehousing, Transitional Housing, Scattered Site Housing and Homeless Prevention & Diversion.



Crisis Assistance

Since 2002, WeCAN (Western Crisis Assistance Network) has been providing help to community members who find themselves facing eviction, utility cutoffs, heating fuel shortage, and prescription medication needs. This assistance often prevents homelessness.
