



Announcement from the Northwest Continuum of Care (NWCoC), NC-516

FY 2021 Continuum of Care Program

Competition is Now Open as of August 18, 2021

- The **NC-516 estimated Annual Renewal Demand (ARD)** is: **\$340,246**. Additional funding for a **CoC Bonus Project** is **\$34,260**, **DV Bonus** is **\$102,780**. **CoC Planning** is **\$20,556**. Please refer to the link above for specific requirements for available funding.
- The Project Applications are available online in *e-snaps* beginning Thursday, August 19, 2021 and can be accessed at <https://esnaps.hud.gov/grantium/frontOffice.jsf>.
- The NC 516 Consolidated Application deadline is **Tuesday, November 16, 2021 at 8:00 PM**. NC-516 plans to post the ***Consolidated Application and Project Priority Listing*** containing the ***Project Applications by Friday, November 12, 2021*** to ensure CoC gets early submission points.

The Electronic Application in *e-snaps* became available **Thursday, August 19, 2021** for Project Applicants to begin work on their Project Applications. **Project Applications for all new, renewal, bonus funds, and CoC Planning projects must be submitted in e-snaps on or before Friday, October 15, 2021 at 8:00 PM EDT** to allow adequate time for review and ranking by the CoC.

Submitted Project Applications will be reviewed and written notification regarding whether project application(s) will be included as part of the CoC Project Priority Listing Submission to all project applicants no later than **Wednesday, October 27, 2021 by 5:00 PM EDT**. Project Application Approval/Denial/Ranking and Appeals will be accepted Thursday, October 28th and Friday, October 29th with Appeals Decisions sent to Project Applicants no later than **Tuesday, November 2, 2021 by 5:00 PM EDT**. **Approved Project Applicants are expected to have submitted their final project application in e-Snaps by Tuesday, November 2, 2021 by 8:00 pm EDT**.

All parts of the 2021 CoC Consolidated Application will be posted and available to the community for inspection by verbal or written request to the Collaborative Applicant: Tina Krause c/o Hospitality House at 338 Brook Hollow Road, Boone, NC 28607, 828-264-1237, director@hosphouse.org. Arrangements will be

made to provide and review any or all parts of the CoC Consolidated Application in a manner that is effective for persons with disabilities and persons with Limited English Proficiency (LEP).

All agencies interested in applying for a new project may notify the Collaborative Applicant: Tina Krause, NWCoC Chair of their interest in submitting an application for further information or technical assistance.

To be eligible to apply for a new project, the applicant/agency must:

1. Be an active CoC member or commit to attending monthly meetings and serving on at least one committee and commit to working on the CoC Application,
2. Agree to any reporting requirements and use of either HMIS or comparable database for victim service applicants,
3. Complete the online Project Application in e-snaps and submit it to the CoC by **Friday, October 15, 2021** for review and ranking by the CoC on the Priority Listing, and
4. Be responsible for any match requirement.
